## **Audubon Nature Institute 2019 Fall/Winter Schedule Begins**

(New Orleans, La.) - Summer is winding down, and that means changes are coming to Audubon Nature Institute's schedule.

### **Fall/Winter Schedule**

All attractions (except Audubon Louisiana Nature Center) are closed on Mondays beginning Monday, September 9 through the end of February. These Audubon attractions will resume a seven-days-a-week schedule in March. The following excludes special holiday openings: the Monday before Thanksgiving, November 25; Monday, December 23; New Year's Eve, December 31; Martin Luther King Day, January 20; and Lundi Gras, February 24.

### **Cool Zoo/Gator Run Water Park**

Cool Zoo and the Gator Run lazy river are open August 31 through September 2 for the Labor Day weekend before closing for the fall and winter. Both will reopen in the spring.

Interpretive Center open Wednesday through Sunday 10:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
