Spooky Family Fun at Boo at the Zoo

This spooky party will be held October 25-27. This year’s event features themed experiences including:

The fun also includes nightly animal encounters and live entertainment on two stages: the Oogie Boogie Stage (Capital One Bank Stage) and Monster Mash Bash (Shell's Wildlife on Stage!) Contests for best group costume and best stroller/wagon decorations will be held each night of the event at the Oogie Boogie Stage.

This spooky party will be held from 5 p.m. to 9 p.m. on Friday, October 25, and Saturday, October 26. The Sunday, October 27, event will be held from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Audubon Zoo will close at 3:00 p.m. each night of Boo at the Zoo to prepare.

The Ghost Train ride line will close at 7:30 p.m. on October 25 and 26 and at 6:30 p.m. on October 27. All animal habitats will be closed during Boo at the Zoo.
