Audubon Nature Institute 2018 Fall/Winter Schedule Begins

Tuesday-through-Sunday schedule begins September 11

(New Orleans, La.) - Summer is winding down and that means changes are coming to Audubon Nature Institute's schedule, including Cool Zoo/Gator Run water park, which will be open Saturday, September 1, Sunday, September 2 and Labor Day, September 3, before closing for the 2018 season.

Beginning September 10, Audubon Zoo, Audubon Aquarium of the Americas, Audubon Butterfly Garden and Insectarium and Entergy Giant Screen Theater will be closed on Mondays through the end of February excluding special holiday openings the Monday before Thanksgiving, November 19; New Year's Eve, December 31; Martin Luther King Day, January 21; and Lundi Gras, March 4.

Audubon Zoo will be open 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Saturdays and Sundays and 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesday to Friday through February. Operating hours at the Aquarium and Entergy Giant Screen Theater will remain 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Tuesday through Sunday. Insectarium operating hours will remain 10 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Tuesday through Sunday.

Audubon attractions will resume a seven-days-a-week schedule in March.

Cool Zoo and the Gator Run lazy river will be open September 2 through September 4 for the Labor Day weekend before closing for the fall and winter. The water park will reopen in the spring.
